

**IF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY OCCURS
CALL TRIPLE ZERO (000) IMMEDIATELY
AND ASK FOR AN AMBULANCE**

YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. Name of ground or venue
2. Suburb
3. Street Name
4. Nearest cross street
5. Emergency vehicle access point (if there is one)
6. Phone number you are calling from

**BE NEAR THE PATIENT WHEN YOU CALL. YOU WILL BE ASKED
TO ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:**

1. What is the problem?
2. How old is the patient?
3. Are they breathing?
4. Are they conscious?

**THE ABOVE CAN BE APPLIED TO A HELICOPTER CALL OUT AS WELL.
ADDITIONALLY, CLUBS SHOULD HAVE A CROWD CONTROL METHOD
THAT CAN BE READILY DEPLOYED.**

**AS A GENERAL SUGGESTION THE MIDDLE OF THE RUGBY FIELD AS THE
LANDING PAD SHOULD WORK IF NO OVERHEAD WIRES EXIST AND THE
PERIMETER IS ABLE TO BE CLEARED.**

**An ambulance will be
dispatched based on the
location and information you
provide.**

**Stay on the line and the Triple Zero (000) call
taker will provide first aid information to assist the
patient until a paramedic arrives.**
