Saturday 21st August 2021 [Dalby Junior Closing Carnival](#) to proceed and [Darling Downs Super Schools Cup](#) recommences Wednesday 25th August 2021 in line with below provisions.

Further to announcements yesterday: from 4pm Friday 20th August 2021 [restrictions will ease](#) in the Local Government Areas ("LGA's") South-East Queensland ("SEQ") of Brisbane, Gold Coast, Ipswich, Lockyer Valley, Logan, Noosa, Moreton Bay, Redland, Scenic Rim, Somerset, Sunshine Coast

Stage 2 – Applies to residents from the above-mentioned 11 SEQ LGA's, as it specifically relates to activities conducted by Downs Rugby and our affiliated Clubs and Schools:

- **Community Sport:** Can recommence in full including training, competition and school sport, spectators in line with stadiums, indoor and outdoor event requirements – click [here](#)
- You must carry a face mask with you at all times when you leave home, unless you have a lawful reason not to. Follow instructions [here](#) on when to wear a mask.

Stage 3 – Rest of Queensland (outside the above-mentioned SEQ 11 LGA's), as it specifically relates to activities conducted by Downs Rugby and our affiliated Clubs and Schools:

- **Community Sport:** No restrictions.
